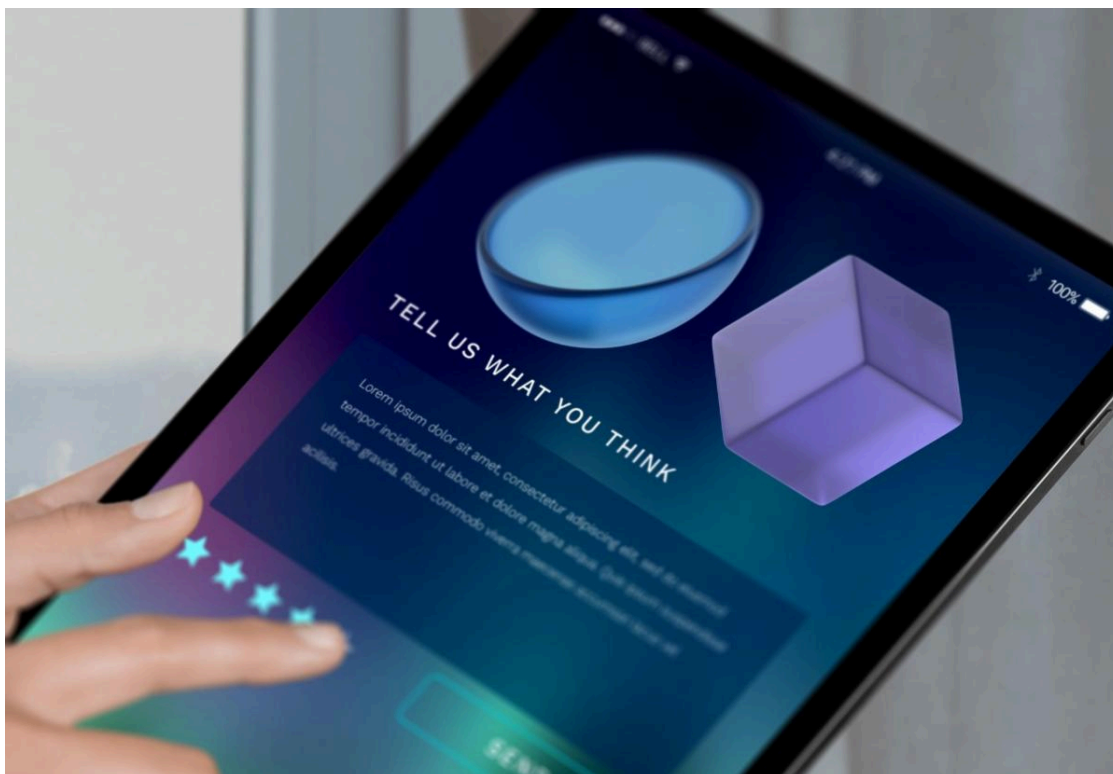

Another effective strategy is to check the language used in reviews. Fake ones often sound generic, overly promotional, or lack specific details about the experience. In contrast, authentic reviews tend to include personal insights and concrete examples.

Cross-checking reviews across multiple platforms can also help verify credibility. If feedback is consistent across trusted sources, it is more likely to be reliable. Additionally, reviewing the reviewer's history can reveal whether they frequently post similar comments, which may indicate suspicious activity.
